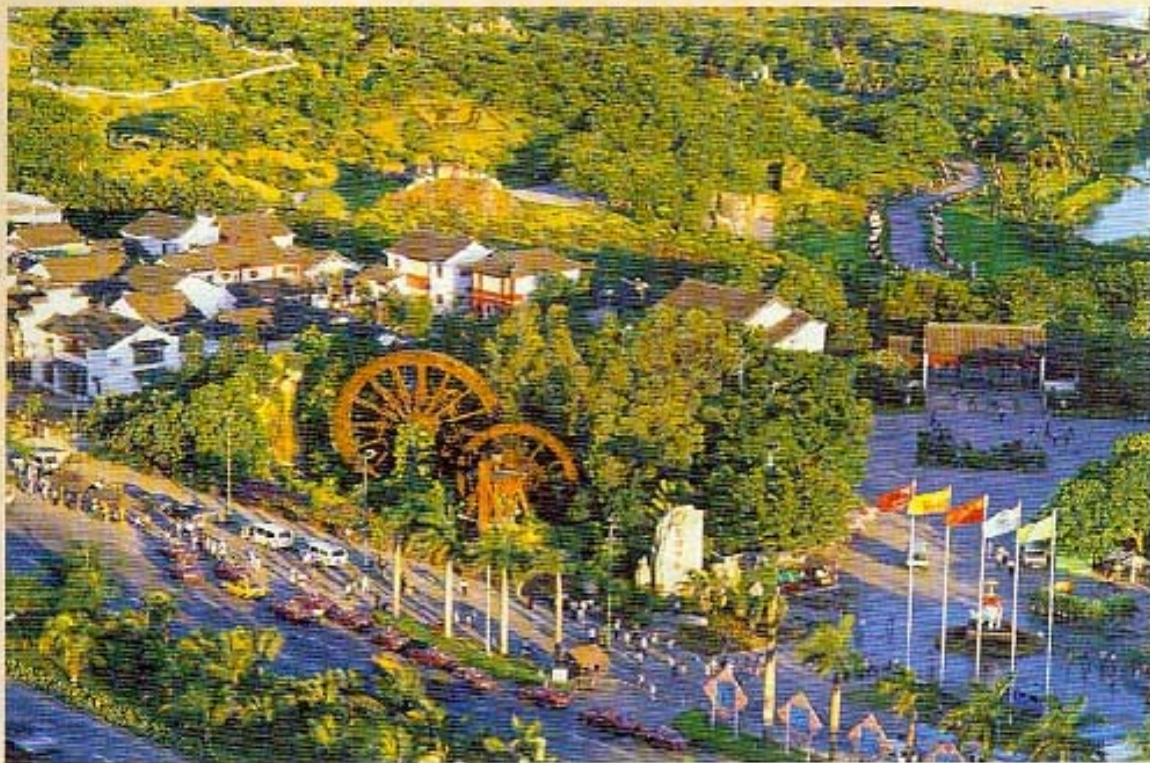


Shenzhen — A City of Joy

Chinese Folk Culture Theme Park

Splendid China Miniature Scenic Spot and Chinese Folk Culture Villages located at the picturesque Shenzhen Bay, are owned and run by Shenzhen Splendid China Development Co., Ltd. They are the earliest and most representative theme parks in China. So far, it has attracted more than 50 million visitors from all over the world, including hundreds of foreign heads of state, government leaders and international celebrities.

In early 2003, the two theme parks were merged into one comprehensive Chinese Folk Culture Theme Park.

At the Splendid China section, the visitors can virtually set feet in history and tour the whole of China in one single day. This section highlights China's 5,000-year-old history and culture and its various scenic attractions. It is a concentrated display of China's history, culture, architecture and folk customs.

The Chinese Folk Culture Villages section features the costumes of China's various ethnic minorities, their architecture, customs and varieties of folk arts. Here, there are graceful folk dance performances as well as breathtaking games for the visitors. The grand dance performances, "Proud Son of Heaven" and "Oriental Fashions", are purely artistic enjoyment for the visitors.
